### New studies

- The **Clinical Record Interactive Search (CRIS) system**: a linked cohort of individuals who have accessed the South London and Maudsley (SLaM) NHS Foundation Trust. 
- The **Intellectual Disability and Mental Health: Assessing the Genomic Impact on Neurodevelopment (IMAGINE ID)**: a national longitudinal cohort study on the genetic causes of intellectual disability. 
- The **National Surveys of Sexual Attitudes and Lifestyle (NATSAL)**: one of the world's largest studies on sexual behaviour since 1990. 


